AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR AN AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY VEHICLE THEFT STUDY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Automobile theft authority vehicle theft study; report

3 On or before October 1, 2006, the automobile theft authority shall:

4 1. Report to the legislature on the feasibility of establishing the
5 following:

6 (a) A comprehensive strategy to combat southbound and cross-border
7 traffic in stolen vehicles, including the identification of recommended
8 resources.

9 (b) A public education campaign to prevent vehicle theft, including
10 the identification of geographic hot spots that are updated on a regular
11 basis.

12 2. Make recommendations regarding the technological and manufacturing
13 responses that make vehicles more theft resistant, including recommendations
14 for phasing in the use of transponder keys in all vehicles in this state.
